Praxis II Success Boot Camp for Elementary Education (K-6)

June 26-27, 2008 & July 17-18, 2008

The NC Model Teacher Education Consortium is pleased to announce a Praxis II Success Boot Camp for K-6 licensure candidates needing to take and pass Praxis II. The Praxis Success Boot Camp comprises 4 full days of intensive in-class instruction along with follow-up during the three week interval between the June session and the July session.

Criteria for Participation: Priority will be given to prospective elementary teachers currently employed by an NCMTEC partnering school system. Candidates should have previously taken Praxis II and must have registered to take it again on July 26, 2008.

Program Content: The Praxis II Success Boot Camp will provide intensive personalized in-class/out of class instruction presented in three components. This rigorous test preparation will include a total of 4 days face-to-face instruction and will continue with out of class assignments during the three-week interval.

Dates: Part I - June 26-27, 2008, Chapel Hill, NC
Part II - June 28-July 16, 2008 (Some out of class assignments with feedback provided.)
Part III - July 17-18, 2008, Chapel Hill, NC

Location: UNC Center for School Leadership Development
Chapel Hill, NC 27517

Cost: \$100 (nonrefundable) co-pay for employees of NCMTEC partnering school systems
\$500 (nonrefundable) for employees of non partnering school systems

The nonrefundable co-pay will assist toward program expenses, meals, and lodging which will be provided by NCMTEC. Participants are responsible for the cost of travel to and from Chapel Hill.
