***MTEC SERVICES – Spring 2010***

**Community College Sponsored Courses**

Courses required for a degree or licensure in teacher education for paraprofessionals and lateral entry teachers are offered at \$25 per semester hour at partnering community colleges. MTEC will also pay up to \$125 per course for required textbooks. Forms are available at [www.ncmtec.org](http://www.ncmtec.org) **Clients may receive assistance for two courses for Spring 2010.**

**University Sponsored Courses**

Undergraduate level teacher education courses at partnering universities are offered at \$35 per semester hour. Graduate level teacher education courses at partnering universities which are needed to clear a teaching license are offered at \$75 per semester hour. **Clients may receive assistance for two courses for Spring 2010.**

**Non Sponsored Course Tuition Reimbursement**

Clients who are clearing a lateral entry license or provisional license and need courses to clear the license will be eligible for either two Non-Sponsored Course Tuition Reimbursements, two University Sponsored Courses or one of each. MTEC will reimburse the cost of the course minus the copay of \$35 per semester hour for undergraduate courses and \$75 per semester hour for graduate courses. The maximum tuition reimbursement will be \$495 per course. Submission of the on-line Tuition Reimbursement Pre-Approval, located on our website, is required by January 15, 2010. Priority will be given to courses from our partnering universities and accredited North Carolina Teacher Education programs. Please note that tuition reimbursement is contingent upon the availability of funding; therefore, actual reimbursement may be less than, but no more than \$495 per three-hour course.

**Praxis I and II Test Preparation**

**Student Teaching Services**

MTEC paraprofessionals may apply for a need-based stipend while student teaching when required to take an unpaid leave of absence from the school system. Required tuition and fees of up to \$600 for each 3 hour course at an MTEC partnering university for the student teaching semester will also be paid. (Financial aid in the form of grants or scholarships must be exhausted before MTEC funds are used.)
